







- · Minimum: At least 1 course


Course Credit

INSURANCE

International Students

- International Health/Travel Insurance
 - Must be written in English.
 - Must submit the full policy of the insurance.
 - Must cover the whole program period.
 - The beneficiary must be the student.

Korean Nationals

- National Health Insurance(의료보험증)
 - Must submit the full policy of the insurance.
 - Must cover the whole program period.
 - If you haven't paid for a certain period, you need to resume the payment first.

HISS Group Insurance

- **DB** Insurance
 - You can purchase through the link on the HISS Website.
 - Complete payment through wire transfer.
 - Group Rate: KRW 25,000~30,000

Submission Deadline: 2 Weeks Before Arrival

How to claim medical fees?











Visit the nearby hospital for medical treatment.

Upon payment, request an itemized bill and doctor's note for your treatment.

File a health insurance claim to your insurance company.

Consult Korean Consulate

- Indicate your visiting period and the purpose of the visit.
- Ask for eligible visa types for your visit to Korea.


Know Your Visa Type

- K-ETA (Korea Electronic Travel Authorization)
 - Required for all nationals coming from visa-free countries/regions.
 - Some nationals may enter Korea with K-ETA but may be restricted for studying purposes. In this case, please apply for the C-3-1 visa below.
- C-3-1 (Short-term General Visit)
 - Eligible for individuals intending to visit Korea for a short period to participate in events and meetings or to obtain skills through a Korean organization.
- D-2-8 (Short-term Study Visa)
 - Eligible for individuals who intend to study in Korea for a certain period.
 - As D-2-8 is the most complicated visa, please consult the Consulate for C-3-1 or K-ETA before applying for this visa.

- The office can provide the below documents for visa purposes.
 - C-3-1: Certificate of Business Registration, Invitation Letter, Admission Letter
 - D-2-8: Certificate of Enrollment

COURSES

in Korea

- To maximize the learning experience, students are encouraged to take a course related to Korean Studies or East Asia Studies during the HISS.
- Students can take up to three(3) courses and gain up to nine(9) credits at the HISS.

in Japan

- Three(3) special lectures will be delivered while traveling to Japan.
- Lectures will be taught by professors from the Waseda university, covering topics about culture, politics, and business, etc.

Upon Completion

- A digital badge for completion of the HYLION Program.
- An official transcript from Hanyang University for the courses taken at HISS.
- A certificate of completion from Waseda University.





BE THE EXPERT OF BAST ASIA

VISA/ INSURANCE

For the HYLION program, students must consult each consulate for the proper visa type. Please refer to the below guideline when consulting the consulate.

Korea

01

- Check your eligibility for the K-ETA.
- If you are not eligible for K-ETA, check your eligibility for the multientry tourist visa (C-3).
- As the program requires multiple entries to Korea, students must apply for a visa that fulfills this requirement.

02

Japan

- Consult the Japanese consulate and check your eligibility for visa exemption to Japan.
- If you need a visa to enter Japan, apply for a short-term stay visa in the country you are currently studying at.

03

Insurance

All HYLION participants are required to submit travel/health insurance.

- · The beneficiary must be the student.
- · Must cover the whole program period.
- Must cover Korea & Japan.
